#### TUITION & FEES

- The Annual Registration Fee is \$35 and is nonrefundable except in the case of cancelled or rescheduled classes. Students who register on, or before, the recital in May will receive a \$16.00 savings on August's tuition.
- Tuition is an annual fee based on the number of lessons offered over the course of the season. It may be paid in monthly installments or paid in full on or before 10/01/18 with a 5% discount. There are no adjustments for months with holidays or extra charges for months with five weeks.
- Tuition is due by the 1st of the month. If accounts are paid after the tenth of the month, there will be a \$15 late fee applied to the account balance. Late fees are applied to all monies owed, including Tuition, Costume Deposits/Balances and Recital Production Fees.
- Costumes fees are based on the number of hours and/or classes a student takes, as follows: \$75 if student takes one hour a week, \$85 if the student takes a class requiring 1 ¼ or more hours per week, and \$70 for each additional costume required.
- Costume Fee DEPOSITS are due with October's tuition, Costume Fee BALANCES are due with December's tuition, Recital Production Fees are due with February's tuition. Costume and recital production fees are nonrefundable; moreover, costumes ordered late will incur a \$25 shipping and handling fee, assuming the costume is still available from the costume company.
- A \$25 fee will be charged for any returned check. If the school receives two insufficient funds checks, all future tuition and fees must be paid with cash, cashier's check or a money order.
- We do not mail monthly statements. If you receive a bill, it is because we believe your account is in arrears. No student will be allowed to take class if the account is two or more months past due. Unpaid tuition /fees will be referred to an attorney or collection agency. Any and all collection costs/attorney fees incurred are the responsibility of the parent.
- Costumes will be distributed beginning Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Students' accounts must be current through the end of May in order for students to receive their costume(s).

**ATTENDANCE**

We realize there are times when arriving late or missing a class is unavoidable; however, we ask you to **please do your best to ensure your child's opportunity for success!** Students who miss classes find it difficult to maintain the level of technical progress of their fellow students. If your child must miss, please make-up the class as soon as possible. There are no refunds for missed classes. **I have read the above and agree.**

**PERFORMANCES**

The Gainesville School of Ballet holds annual recitals providing students with an opportunity to perform for their family, friends, and others. A costume fee and a \$45 recital production fee, per nuclear family, will be charged. The amount of the costume fee varies depending on the class level and the number of classes in which your child is enrolled. The costume fee is not a rental fee; the costume(s) will be yours to keep. Only students who have purchased a costume and wear their costume during the rehearsal and recital will be allowed to participate.

The Recital Production Fee includes two tickets; more importantly, it *helps* to defray the costs of the theatre rental, tech crew, and recital program preparation. Additional tickets for the recital will be \$8 per person. If you do not intend for your child to perform in the recital, please notify the school by October 1<sup>st</sup>, when the first costume fee deposit is due.

Students who want to perform in the recital **MUST** attend the rehearsal on Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup>.

**MEDICAL EMERGENCY**

The undersigned gives permission to GSB, its owners and operators to seek medical treatment for the student in the event they are not able to reach a parent or guardian. **WITHDRAWALS**

We hate to see you go! But, if you need to withdraw for any reason you are required to give notice before the end of the month or you **WILL BE CHARGED** for the next month. You must personally submit the withdrawal form in your coupon book to a person on staff in the office. It will not be sufficient to merely tell an instructor or supervisor, leave a voice mail or send an email of your intent,. You will be responsible for tuition and late fees accrued during the month of your withdrawal notification and if we do not receive your withdrawal form, you will be billed for one additional month.

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK**

I agree that if my dependent or I (heretofore known as "we") engage in any physical exercise, class, or activity or facility on the premises or any venue where we participate as representatives of the Gainesville School of Ballet (GSB), we do so at our own risk. I agree that we are voluntarily participating in activities and use of said facilities, premises (including the parking lot). We assume all risk of injury, illness, damage, or loss to us or our property that might result, including, without limitation, any loss or theft of any personal property. I agree that this consent and assumption of risk statement covers each and every event or activity sponsored by GSB. I agree to release and discharge you (and your affiliates, employees, agents, representatives, successors, and assigns) from any and all claims or cause of action (known or unknown) arising out of negligence. I acknowledge that I have carefully read this Waiver and Release and fully understand that it is a release of liability. I am waiving any right that I may have to bring legal action to assert a claim against you for your negligence. As the legal parent or guardian, I release and hold harmless GSB, its owners and operators from any and all liability, claims, demands, and causes of action whatsoever, arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by the participant and/or the undersigned, while in or upon the premises or any premises under the control and supervision of GSB, its owners and operators or in route to or from any of said premises. I further acknowledge I will be responsible for any and all medical or related bills that may be incurred for any illness or injury that the participant may sustain during the event and while traveling to and from the site whether or not the event actually occurs.
